Club rules

1. The purpose of the club is to provide financial support to St Michael's Catholic Grammar School.
2. The Club is not limited in size and membership is open to all who wish to join.
3. Each member will be advised of his or her allocated number.
4. The entry fee for each monthly draw is £10
5. The subscription can only be paid by either:
 - a. monthly subscription to be paid by standing order on the 1st of each month; or
 - b. yearly subscription of £120 to be paid by cheque on or before the 1st of November each year.
6. The draw will be held at a meeting of the St Michael's Parents Association or another public forum at the school after the 15th of each calendar month.
7. When the draw falls in the school holidays, an alternative date will be selected by the Committee.
8. All prizes will be paid via cheque and will be posted within seven days of the draw taking place.
9. The results of each draw will be notified to the 200 Club membership by email within seven days of the draw taking place
10. The Committee will review the size of the prize fund in accordance with the membership at least annually
11. The Committee will decide in consultation with the school which projects to support
12. The Committee's decision on all matters shall be final.
