Economics is taught within the faculty of Social Sciences which currently comprises of the head of Department and 5 other teachers. Economics is a popular subject and groups are shared between to part time Economics teachers.

Results are broadly in line with the School Development Plan's grade targets of 99% A-E, 80% A*-B.

The Department was highly praised by OFSTED in February 2005 and January 2008.

Subjects are open to students both from within St. Michael's and from the local Catholic boys school – Finchley Catholic High which also has healthy Sixth Form numbers of over 200 students. The subjects taught on the St. Michael's site have a number of students commuting from the boys' school and are very popular with St. Michael's girls. Progression to A2 in Year 13 requires students to obtain at least a grade C at AS level at the end of Year 12.
