 - francophone Cinema
 - Francophone music
 - Charities in France
 - Integration in France
- 2. Then create a portfolio/scrapbook including:
 - The document itself or a photo/photocopy of the document.
 - The list of the vocabulary you had to search.
 - An in depth summary IN ENGLISH of the document, film, etc... and what you have learnt from it.
